

Your transfer to this facility under these conditions is based on the following specific information:

Your current offenses of conviction are for Conspiracy to Commit Murder in a Foreign Country; Conspiracy to Kidnap, Maim, and Torture; and Providing Material Support to a Terrorist Organization. You acted in a criminal conspiracy to raise money to support mujahideen operations and used religious training to recruit other individuals in furtherance of criminal acts in this country as well as many countries abroad. Your offense conduct included significant communication, association and assistance to al-Qaida, a group which has been designated as a foreign terrorist organization.

Based on this information, your transfer to this facility for greater communication management is necessary to the safe, secure, and orderly operation of Bureau institutions, or protection of the public. Your continued designation to this facility will be reviewed regularly by your Unit Team under circumstances providing you notice and an opportunity to be heard, in accordance with the Bureau's policy on Classification and Program Review of Inmates.

OPPORTUNITY TO APPEAL TRANSFER DECISION - You may appeal this transfer decision, or any conditions of your confinement, through the Bureau's Administrative Remedy Program, 28 C.F.R. §§ 542.10 through 542.19, and corresponding policy. A member of your Unit Team will provide you with the necessary form upon request.



This is in response to your Regional Administrative Remedy Appeal received in this office on August 28, 2008, in which you allege you were inappropriately placed in the Communication Management Unit (CMU). You believe your placement at the CMU violates your constitutional rights. You request a transfer.

We have reviewed your appeal and the Warden's response dated August 1, 2008. The Bureau of Prisons has the authority to make designation assignments they deem appropriate and necessary to ensure the safe and orderly operation of its facilities, and the protection of the public. You were transferred to the CMU so that additional monitoring of your communication could be accomplished. This was deemed necessary due to your current offense of Conspiracy to Murder, Kidnap, and Maim Persons in a Foreign Country, Conspiracy to Provide Material Support to Terrorism and Material Support to Terrorists. Additionally, you maintained significant communication and association with foreign terrorist organizations. You have provided insufficient evidence that your placement violates your constitutional rights, is inappropriate, or contrary to agency policy.

Based on the above information, your Regional Administrative Remedy Appeal is denied.

If you are dissatisfied with this response, you may appeal to the Office of General Counsel, Federal Bureau of Prisons, 320 First Street, NW, Washington, DC 20534. Your appeal must be received in the Office of General Counsel within 30 days from the date of this response.

Part B - Response

This is in response to your Central Office Administrative Remedy in which you appeal your placement in the Communications Management Unit (CMU). You claim your placement in the CMU violates your Constitutional rights and no due process was followed in placing you in this unit. You request to be transferred to a general population facility that is closer to your home as recommended by the sentencing judge.

The Bureau of Prisons (Bureau) has the authority to make housing unit and institution assignments that support the security and orderly operation of the institution. The CMU was established to house inmates that due to their current offense, offense conduct, or other information, require increased monitoring of communication between inmates and persons in the community in order to protect the safety, security, and orderly operation of Bureau facilities, and the public. The CMU is a self-contained general population housing unit that can house all security levels and provides for greater management of an inmate's communication. Designation to the CMU is not punitive.

Our review revealed the Warden and Regional Director's responses have adequately advised you of the reasons for your placement in the CMU which warrant greater management of your communications and we find no need to elaborate. You have been appropriately designated to the CMU. Your transfer to the CMU was not a disciplinary sanction, therefore, there are no due process rights attached to this administrative decision. As for the sentencing judge's recommendation, the Bureau makes every effort to satisfy a judicial recommendation, however, Congress has given the Bureau sole discretionary authority to designate an inmate's place of confinement under 18 U.S.C. § 3621(b). Inmates have no entitlement to placement in a particular institution. Staff will continue to monitor your case during regularly scheduled program reviews. We concur with the responses provided.

Accordingly, your appeal is denied.



CORRECTIONAL PROGRAMS: Kifah Jayyousi's current offense includes Conspiracy to Murder, Kidnap, and Maim Persons in a Foreign Country, Conspiracy to Provide Material Support to Terrorism and Material Support to Terrorists. Jayyousi was a supporter of Sheikh Omar Abdel Rahman and Abu Hamza. According to information, Jayyousi opened a bank account in the name of the "Islamic Group." He also published a newsletter called the Islam Report under the guise of "The American Islamic Group," (AIG). Jayyousi assumed the role as president for the "American Worldwide Relief Organization," (AWR). Jayyousi along with his co-defendants raised money to support mujahideen operations for AIG, AWR, Global Relief Foundation (GRF), and other terrorist organizations. Jayyousi and his co-defendants tried to establish Islamic states governed by Islamic laws. He is a care level 1 inmate. He is sentenced to serve 152 months with 20 years SRT. Your transfer to this unit, by itself, has no effect on the length of your incarceration. You will continue to earn good-conduct sentence credit in accordance with Bureau policy.

You were sentenced with a terrorism enhancement. Records from your PSI clearly defines association with terrorism. Additionally, sensitive reporting from other law enforcement agencies was used to determine your placement in the CMU.

Additionally, you are appealing CIM issues not originally addressed in the Informal Resolution Form. These issues will not be addressed in this response.

Therefore, your request for Administrative Remedy is denied.

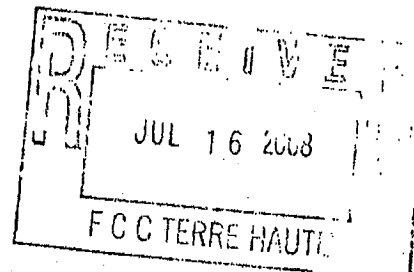

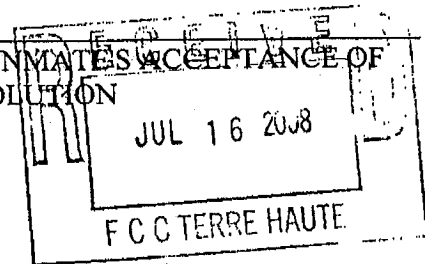
