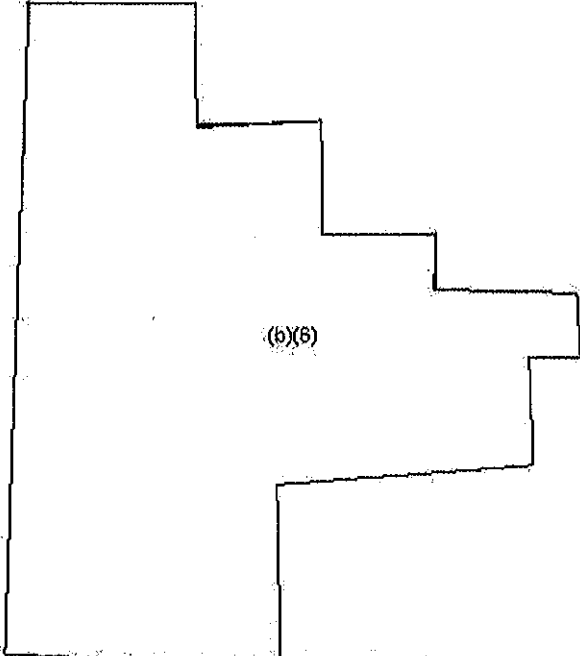
• **[REDACTED] Gaza Flotilla:** The Turkish National Security Council (MGK) was to meet late 2 June to recommend a new course for Turkey's bilateral relationship with Israel after the flotilla interception. The parliament unanimously denounced the interception as a violation of the UN Charter and international law, and called for sanctions against Israel. The statement distinguishes the flotilla from the Israeli people as the target of Turkish national anger. Ministry of Justice contacts told the Embassy PM Erdogan is interested in pursuing a possible criminal case against Israeli officials. In Ankara, protests continued 2 June, but their size has diminished. In Kuwait, the PM, National Assembly Speaker and large crowds hailed as heroes Kuwait's 16 "Freedom Flotilla" participants on their 2 June return from Israel. Returnees condemned the Israelis as "terrorists," and accused them of abuse and intense interrogations. Of ships still believed to be en route to Gaza, the RACHEL CORRIE is expected to arrive at a staging point near Cyprus early 3 June. The CHALLENGER II and Greek-flagged DIMITRIS-K are docked in Cyprus. IDF officials have not informed the Embassy of specific actions, but have confirmed the ships will not be allowed to reach Gaza. Just five minutes – this is the estimated time it took Israel's Navy to commandeer the Rachel Corrie Ship en route to the Gaza Strip.

The raid got underway with the vessel roughly 23 miles west of the Gaza shore, right on the boundary of the naval blockade imposed on the ship. Navy Chief Major General Elisher Maron received the chief of staff's approval before proceeding. The top military officials were also in touch with Defense Minister Ehud Barak during the operation.

The overall operation was headed by the commander of Israel's missile boat fleet, while the actual raid on the ship was led by the commander of the Flotilla 13 commando unit, Colonel A.

The decision to take over the vessel was taken roughly at 12 pm, when it became clear that the ship had no intention of complying with the Navy's messages and turn to the Ashdod port for an inspection.

The vessel's captain was informed that Navy soldiers may board the ship in the ship's international law and without using force, and that the IDF expected personnel on the ship to behave similarly.

The captain made it clear to the forces he had no intention to offer violent resistance. He gathered the 11 passengers and crewmembers on the ship's deck, where they peacefully waited for the Navy's boats. The Navy dispatched three missile boats to the area, as well as several patrol vessels which have been accompanying the Rachel Corrie since Friday. Additional missile boats were deployed in case the operation turned violent.

Shortly before 12:30, two missile boats reached the Rachel Corrie carrying about 20 combat soldiers, including four female fighters belonging to the Navy's special security unit, in charge of securing ports and vessels. The females were brought in so that they personally handle the females on board, including Nobel Prize Laureate Mairead McGuire.

The Navy commander was on board a nearby missile boat along with Flotilla 13's commander during the operation. The fighters boarded the ship using rope ladders without facing any resistance, explained their demands to the captain, and announced they were being met.

The operation took about five minutes, with soldiers on board the ship yelling slogans at Navy troops but refraining from any violence. The incident highlighted the difference between passengers on board the flotillas, who played a violent and lethal game in order to smother Israel, and Rachel Corrie activists. The Navy said the latter activists were part of a "provocative raid", but made do with conveying their political message, thereby averting any kind of violent clash.

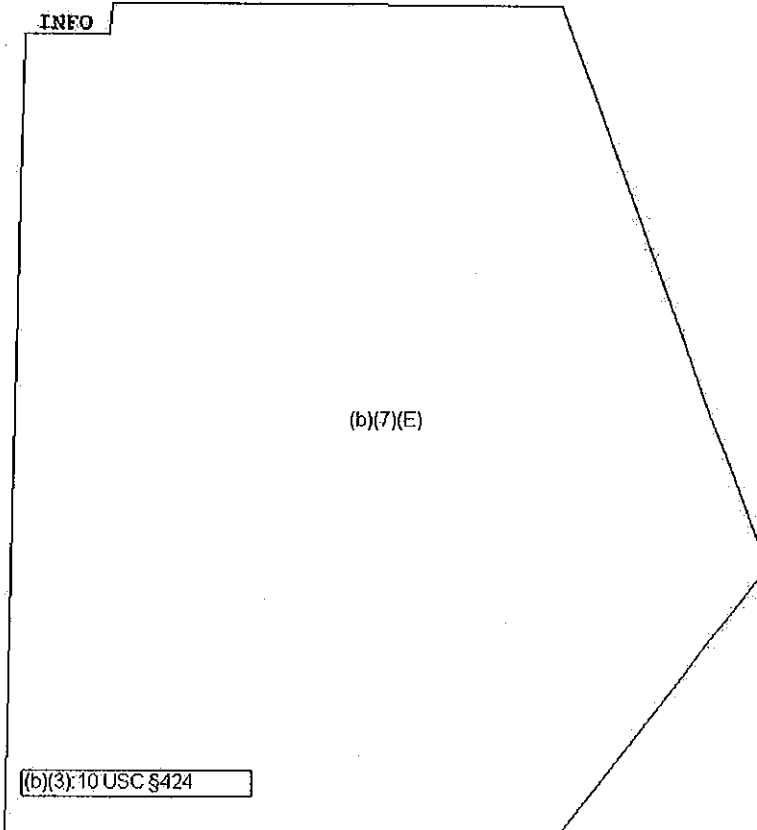

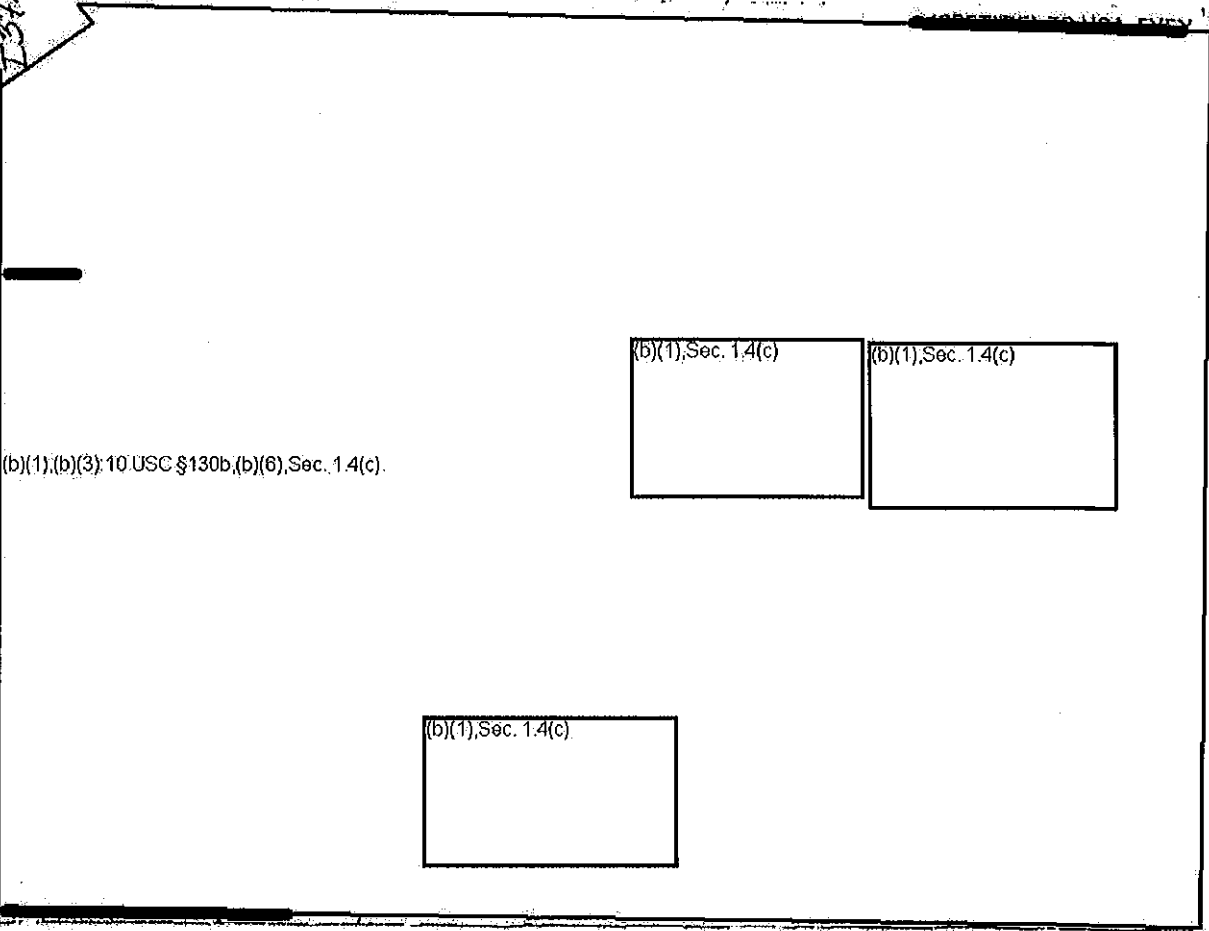



In short, FF2 spokespersons stated the flotilla will press forward with their departure plans despite Israel's warnings.

- (U) On 27 Jun, after two days of closed-doors meetings, the Israeli ministers committee on security affairs voted in favor of the navy plans to stop the FF2 flotilla from breaching the Israeli-imposed naval blockade on the Palestinian territory, giving the army authority to use "all necessary means" during the operation. The Israeli cabinet has ordered Israeli troops to operate with "maximal restraint and avoid clashes with activists on board the vessels."

- (U) At approx 310130Z May, Israeli Defense Forces boarded Turkish MV MAVI MARMARA, lead ship in the flotilla; intercept occurred in international waters (approx 7nm off Huda). IDF commandos boarded via Israeli BLACKHAWK rope drops under cover of darkness.
- (U) Approx 30 activists onboard MAVI MARMARA had cameras and reported that IDF Commandos started shooting "the minute their feet hit

the deck". Videos were immediately posted online. BBC/Al Jazeera reported Israeli Army confirmed at least 10 deaths; more recent news reports have death toll as high as 15, with injuries (including IDF) as high as 50. (U) Turkey's PM has condemned the attack; large protests (over 100,000) have begun in Turkey. Several nations are summoning the Israeli AMBA.

- (U) At 0800Z Israel's Dep. PM held 3 press conferences, claiming weapons were on board, the ships are prepared to retaliate against Israeli forces.
- Flotilla may include several high profile AJCITG to include Ambassador Edward Pack, former Chief of Mission in Mauritania and Iraq. In total, approx 750 activists got off from Iceland, Greece, and Turkey, reportedly carrying 10,000 tons of humanitarian supplies.
- (U) Danny Ayalon, Israeli Dep. PM, delivered remarks via CNN to counter expected allegations of Israeli aggression against the humanitarian relief workers. ISR maintains they offered Free Gaza the opportunity to bring in "approved" goods via the port of Ashdod to Gaza. However, Free Gaza did not accept the offer as many of the supplies they want to bring in are on the list of 2000 banned items to include cement, paper, water filtration systems, etc.
- (U) In Turkey, anti-Israeli protests/demos occurred at the Israeli Embassy in Ankara; (U) Turkey's security forces responded and are maintaining control.

- (U) The first vessel has made it to Ashdod. One US-registered/owned yacht, Challenger 1, is part of the flotilla and is expected to enter Ashdod as well.
- (U) Turkey has cancelled 3 upcoming military exercises with ISR. The IDF's prior anti-Avdygamaht might jeopardize previously unpublicized bilateral exercises.

Way Forward:

- Additional Free Gaza Movement vessels e.g., MV RACHEL CORRIE (currently close to Malta) approach Gaza; IDF will again interdict.
- HAMAS gov't will exploit incident to paint Israel in bad light and re-emphasize Israeli "blockade" as reason for hardships in Gaza. Mass demonstrations likely; HAMAS may Jilin Syria or other likeminded states in calling for violent action; HAMAS is unlikely to break cease-fire over this incident.
- Seek clarification on why boarding happened in international waters.
- Encourage ISR to work with Turkey as relationship is already strained.
- Seek information regarding US-owned/US-registered vessels and status of American citizens involved.

(U) The international "Freedom Flotilla II (FF2) - Stay Human" will include 10 ships, at least two of which are cargo boats carrying aid, while the rest are passenger ships carrying hundreds of people, among them, politicians, MEPs, writers, religious faith representatives, people of arts and culture and activists. Press releases indicate many TV crews will be also on board (CNN, NBC, Al-Jazeera, et al) as well as journalists sent by various world media and newspapers. "Stay Human" was selected in honor of 36-year old Italian pro-Palestinian activist Vittorio Arrigoni, who was killed 14 Apr 2011 after being kidnapped in Gaza City by Salafist radicals.
