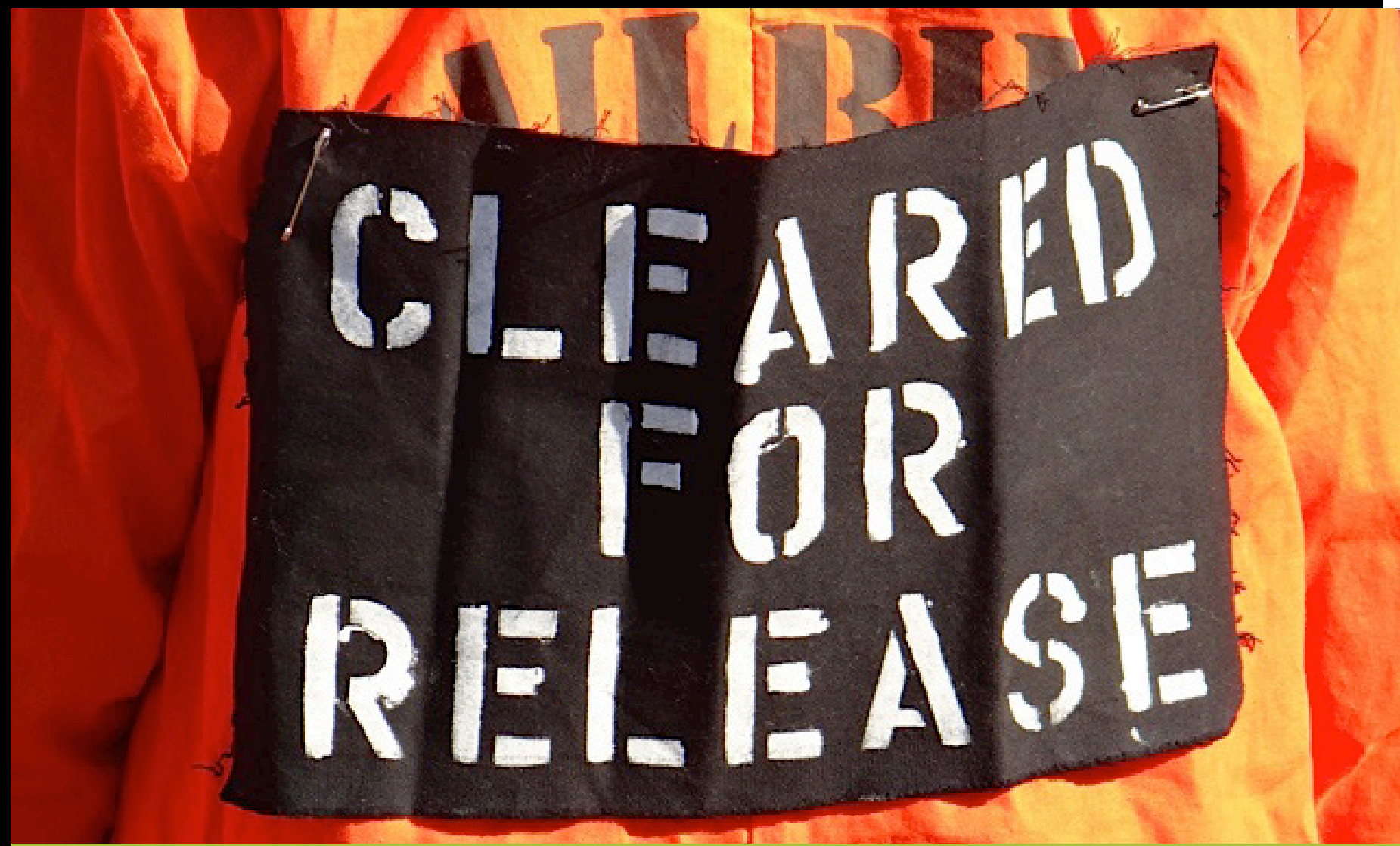


On January 11, 2018, the Guantánamo Bay prison will have been open for 16 years.

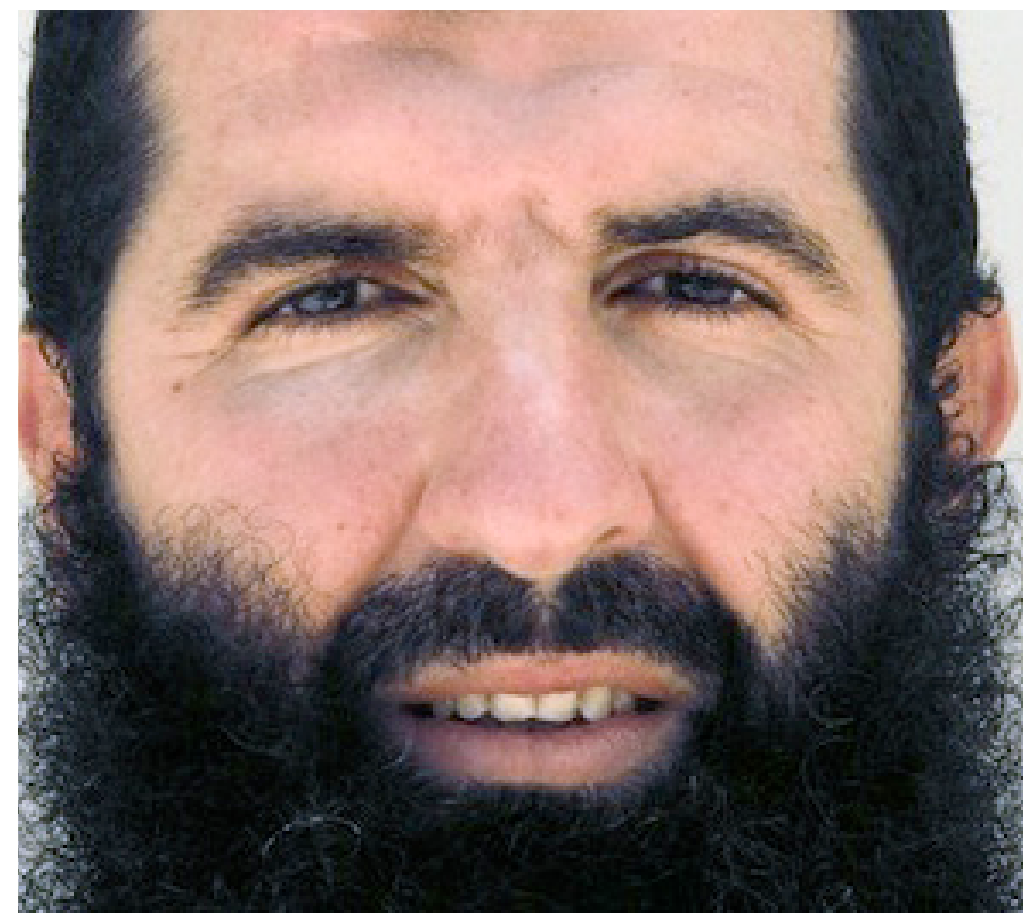
