His Excellency Abdallah Baali,

This letter is to inform you that concerned individuals are now demonstrating in front of the Algerian Embassy in Washington, D.C. We invite you downstairs to see.

They are demonstrating to express their grave concern about the safety of Mr. Djamel Ameziane, who has been sent from Guantánamo to Algeria against his will, and who fears that his human rights will not be respected.

We urge you to immediately release Mr. Djamel Ameziane from detention and to his family. We also urge you to ensure that his human rights are fully respected and protected.

Mr. Djamel Ameziane has suffered greatly, and he must be allowed to rebuild his life in safety and in freedom.

If you wish to discuss this matter further, please contact Mr. Ameziane's counsel at the Center for Constitutional Rights.
