Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56, Plaintiffs hereby move for an Order of Summary Judgment on Count One of their First Amended Complaint on the grounds that transferring Plaintiffs to a Communications Management Unit (CMU) without meaningful notice, hearing, or periodic review of their ongoing placement in the CMU has subjected Plaintiffs to an atypical and significant hardship without due process of law, in violation of the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution. *See* First Am.
