The cable also includes CIA organizational information, CIA filing information, locations of CIA facilities, and the names and/or identifying information of personnel engaged in counterterrorism operations.

This document contains information that has been classified in accordance with sections 1.4(c) of Executive Order 12958, and is protected from disclosure by exemption (b)(1) because it would tend to reveal intelligence activities and sources and methods. Disclosure of this document could reasonably be expected to cause serious damage to the national security. In particular, the document tends to reveal intelligence sources, methods and activities. Disclosure of this document would reveal information that is currently and properly classified.

This document is similarly exempt from disclosure by exemption (b)(3) pursuant to Section 102A(i)(1) of the National Security Act of 1947. Additionally, the document is also withheld under (b)(3) pursuant to Section 6 of the Central Intelligence Agency Act of 1949 because the document reflects internal organizational identifiers and data, as well as internal organizational communications methodologies and routing information.
