6. (SBU) Many within Lebanon have tried to use June Gaza "Freedom Flotilla" incident to raise tensions with Israel, though most Lebanese currently seek continued stability. Hizballah Secretary-General Hassan Nasrallah, in particular, publicly called for the immediate dispatch of Lebanese ships to Gaza in solidarity with the Palestinians. Publicly and privately, some Lebanese observers have assessed that Turkey captured the initiative on the Palestinian issue from Iran by launching the flotilla, and many of them have voiced their belief that Nasrallah was trying to reclaim the issue with his call for a Lebanese rejoinder. According to Lebanese law, no boat can sail from Lebanon to a port controlled by Israel, including Gaza, and the government of Lebanon has said so officially to the U.N. Security Council. Regardless, two groups claim they are preparing to send a boat or boats from Lebanon to Gaza via a third country, possibly Cyprus. Israeli officials have said publicly that they will hold the government of Lebanon responsible should a provocative flotilla be launched from Lebanon.



(SBU) Foreign Minister Anifah visited Brunei on June 14 and Indonesia on June 17 to solicit support for an emergency session of the UN General Assembly to discuss the May 31 attack on the Gaza-bound flotilla. During these visits, Anifah stated that Malaysia would propose the adoption of a UNGA resolution seeking an advisory opinion from the International Court of Justice, as well as to demand the lifting of the Israeli blockade on Gaza in line with UNSCR 1860.
- 4. (SBU) FM Anifah sent a letter to Secretary Clinton, dated June 15, expressing his "grave concern" over the incident (ref C). Anifah's letter said that "Malaysia is deeply disappointed with the response of the United States' Administration over the violent Israeli attack on humanitarian volunteers. 



Subject:

Turkey: Scattered Anti-Semitism in Response to Gaza Flotilla Incident

- 1. (SBU) SUMMARY: Some scattered anti-Semitic incidents occurred in Turkey immediately after the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident, but the Government of Turkey was proactive from the beginning to distance Turkey's Jewish Community from the Government of Israel's actions. The atmosphere has since returned to normal: the government and general public is highly critical of Israel, but takes pains to distinguish between the Government of Israel and Jewish people in general. (Note: This cable and REFS B-E provide Post's response to REF A's request for information on this issue. End Note) END SUMMARY.
- 2. (SBU) The May 31 Gaza flotilla incident initially sparked anger among nationalist Turks -- whether religious or secular -- that temporarily blurred the already thin line that distinguishes Jews from Israelis in Turkey. Although there was no reported increase in violent or disrespectful actions against Turkey's indigenous Jews, non-Turkish Jews living in Turkey or visiting Turkey noted a significant anti-Semitic atmosphere lasting a few weeks after the event. For instance, one Jewish-American family told us they had received an email from a tour guide operator saying that they "did not like working with Jews" and would not guide them in Istanbul.
- 3. (SBU) The atmosphere appears to have reverted to normal, perhaps in part because of the government's strong and continued emphasis that the

Government of Israel does not represent all Jews. The flotilla nonetheless continues to serve as a political focal point for rallying nationalist sentiments, be it by the religious Saadet Party or the left-wing Democratic Left Party (DSP) -- although generally anti-Israeli and not anti-Semitic.

- 4. (SBU) Post has not seen any indications that anti-Israeli sentiment following the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident has permanently crossed the line into anti-Semitism. To the contrary, the Government of Turkey has been proactive from the beginning of the incident to separate Turkey's Jews from the actions of the Israeli government. While some anti-Israeli graffiti appeared in Istanbul shortly after the event it was not anti-Semitic, although it could have been interpreted by some as harassing. All official interlocutors with whom Post has had contact since the event blame the Israeli government, but not Jews in general.
- 5. (U) Post will continue to work closely with Turkey's Jewish Community to monitor the situation and report as the situation warrants.

1. (SBU) **SUMMARY:** On July 1, 2010, the Bundestag unanimously passed a petition that calls on the German government to take a more active stance (1) in demanding an international investigation of the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident, (2) in addressing the humanitarian situation in Gaza, and (3) in supporting the Middle East peace process. This was the first time that all parties formally adopted a common position on a Middle East issue, and it sends a clear mandate to the German government to act. The petition gained a lot of public attention and was met with concern by pro-Israeli interest groups. **END SUMMARY.**

Bundestag Petition Calls for Flotilla Investigation, Addressing Humanitarian Situation, Support for Middle East Peace Process

2. (U) On July 1, 2010, the Bundestag unanimously passed a petition that calls on the German government to support the renewed demand by UN Secretary General for an international investigation of the events surrounding the Israeli military action against the Gaza flotilla on May 31, 2010. The investigation should look at action on both sides, including possible connections of organizers to radical Islamist organizations, and the inclusion of representatives of the Middle East Quartet should be considered. Furthermore, the petition calls upon the German government to strongly support the EU High Representative for Foreign and Security Policy in her initiatives to improve the humanitarian situation in Gaza and, within the EU, to speak up for instructing the UN Secretary General to negotiate with Israel about access to Gaza by sea and creating the necessary technical conditions with the goal of delivering goods needed by the UN to Gaza while at the same time preserving Israel's security interests. The petition also calls on the German government to "strongly support the EU demand for an immediate end to the Gaza blockade and urge Israel to change the positive list of goods allowed into Gaza to a negative list of prohibited goods," to urge Egypt to allow regular and controlled border traffic, and to put forward the offer to Israel and the Palestinian Authority (PA) on behalf of the EU to build up constructive international border management. As a final point, the petition calls for support of the ongoing "proximity talks"

as step towards direct peace talks to achieve a two-state-solution as soon as possible.

For the First Time All Parties Stand United on a Middle East Issue

3. (SBU) The joint Bundestag petition on Gaza is a strong and rare demonstration of unity across party lines. Initiated by foreign policy spokesperson of the Greens Kerstin Müller, the government parties (CDU/CSU and FDP) and the opposition parties (SPD, Greens) worked together in drafting the petition and are co-sponsors of the document. Although the LeftParty is not listed as an official sponsor on the petition, the party caucus did support it in the plenary vote on July 1, 2010, in which the petition was unanimously passed. In the parliamentary debate preceding the vote, foreign policy spokesperson of the Left Party Wolfgang Gehrcke emphasized that this was the first time that all Bundestag caucuses were united on a question regarding Middle East policy. SPD foreign policy spokesperson Rolf Mützenich added: "I consider it a great sign of progress [...] if the German Bundestag manages to achieve a common position on such a serious question." Rainer Stinner, FDP foreign policy spokesperson, said the joint petition demonstrated "a new quality of a common German foreign and security policy." Embassy contacts in the Bundestag equally saw the petition as a sign that "a stronger unity" on the issue was emerging and characterized the political process behind it as "out of the ordinary."

4. (SBU) According to an embassy contact who was closely involved in the process of forging an inter-party consensus on the petition, the political process behind the scenes was not easy. The Left party could not be formally included as a sponsor of the petition since the CDU/CSU caucus refuses to sit on the negotiating table if the Left Party is also present. In addition, the Left Party is known for their anti-Israeli sentiments, and there is general concern that their formal inclusion on the petition might have been counter-productive to the credibility of the document. However, the general support of the petition by the Left Party in the plenary vote was welcomed by all parties. Another difficulty was to keep the CDU/CSU on board throughout the process. As an embassy contact pointed out, some members of the CDU/CSU had strong reservations about the petition. When they made their concerns about a possible impact on German-Israeli relations heard, however, the press work related to the petition had already been done and could not be reversed.

Petition Sends Clear Mandate to the German Government

5. (SBU) Passing a joint petition is one of the few tools the Bundestag has available to directly impact foreign policy. As an embassy contact stressed, such a document should be considered "soft law." Especially since the Gaza petition is supported by all party caucuses, it sends a clear mandate for the government to address the issue. Although there is no legal obligation, it would be "politically impossible" for the government to ignore it. The petition also sends a strong signal of unity to Israel. According to an embassy contact, the petition also attracted the attention of the Israeli participants in a meeting between members of the Bundestag Foreign Affairs Committee and a delegation of the German-Israeli Friendship Group from the Knesset on July 7 in Berlin. Although the issue will likely not gain any immediate further attention due to summer recess, it is likely to reemerge on the agenda in the context of FM Westerwelle's planned visit to Gaza this fall. For the initiators of the petition, the next step is that Germany actively encourages a continuation of the discussion on the European level.

Concerned Reactions from pro-Israeli Interest Groups

6. (SBU) The petition was met with very harsh external criticism from organizations such as the American Jewish Committee (AJC). An embassy contact said that much of this criticism was "not based on content" but rather a "default and blunt rejection." He also stressed that the intensity of the reactions underlined that the petition was an extraordinary policy statement. In the plenary debate preceding the vote on the petition, several speakers emphasized that they had received many external reactions. Rainer Stinner (FDP) said the concerns of

(SBU) The Knesset voted July 13 to remove some parliamentary privileges from Israeli Arab Member of the Knesset (MK) Haneen Zoabi, who had been aboard the Mavi Marmara May 31 when it attempted to break Israel's blockade on the Gaza Strip. The privileges removed include her diplomatic passport and any state funding of legal fees incurred while she is a legislator. Zoabi did not lose her parliamentary immunity from prosecution.

2. (SBU) Yisrael Beiteinu MK Anastasia Michaeli handed Zoabi an Iranian passport with her photo in it as a mock replacement, but was promptly removed from the plenum for doing so. Michaeli reportedly noted to Zoabi that her incitement did not represent most Arabs in Israel, who were faithful to the state. According to press reports, a fistfight also nearly broke out after the vote between Arab MKs who called Jewish MKs "fascists," and Jewish MKs who promised Zoabi that she would soon be a "former MK."

- 1. (SBU) Per reftel request, post has not observed any Venezuelan government (GBRV) reactions to the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident that constitute anti-Semitic expressions according to the definition contained in para 3 of reftel. However, President Chavez and the official media have broadcast several particularly hostile anti-Israel messages.
 - Genocidal State: On June 2, President Chavez said that "the genocidal state of Israel... massacred a group of pacifists ... I take this opportunity to condemn again, from the bottom of my soul ... the State of Israel. Damned be the State of Israel! Damned be it! Terrorists and assassins! Long live the Palestinian people!" Chavez also accused Israel of financing the Venezuelan opposition: "There are even Mossad terrorist groups that follow me trying to kill me . . ." Later in his speech, Chavez said, "They accuse me of being an enemy of the Jews. No, I am not an enemy of the Jews. . . . I send my greetings and respect to the Venezuelan Jewish community. They know they have our affection and our respect, and I find it difficult to believe that a Venezuelan Jew, honest as the majority are, would support this kind of massacre . . . "
 - World Cup: Zionists vs. Palestinians: During the World Cup final match on July 11, an anti-Israel advertisement aired on state-controlled television that showed healthy, young, Israeli athletes attacking a poor, huddled groups of Palestinians in a soccer match. In the ad, an Israeli player shoves an elderly Palestinian man to the ground. An apparently blind referee wearing a "UN" jersey gives the Palestinian man on the ground a yellow card. The Israeli team then takes a penalty shot, with a group of Palestinians, including the elderly man, four women, including a pregnant woman, and a child and a baby, cringing together in front of the goal post. At the bottom of the screen, red text appears: "It's not a game, it's a massacre," followed by, "We are all Palestinians." (SBU) Per Reftel request, we reviewed media, government and societal responses to the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident. We found no Kosovo media coverage or societal responses that could be characterized as anti-Semitic. There were no official government statements or responses. One Kosovo citizen was on the flotilla, and a small group gathered at the airport to receive him when he returned to Kosovo on June 4; otherwise there were no gatherings or protests related to the incident. Media coverage of the incident, which faded from headlines quickly following the return of the Kosovo citizen who was on the flotilla, was largely factual rather than editorial. There was one notable editorial piece related to the incident in the Kosovo newspaper Zeri. The daily's editor argued that Kosovo citizens should not view the participation of a Kosovar on the flotilla as heroic, noting that his participation may harm perceptions of Kosovo abroad.

 Sweden: Limited anti-Semitic reactions to Gaza Flotilla

- 1. (SBU) Summary: Surrounding the May 31 Gaza Flotilla incident:
- -- Swedish authorities reported no increase in individually reported anti-Semitic hate crimes;
- -- The Jewish Community reported to police that there was a small surge in threatening emails, phone calls and text messages, both anti-Israeli and anti-Semitic in nature;
- -- Local media reported that anti-Semitic statements increased slightly on Swedish blogs and internet forums.

End Summary.

- 2. (SBU) Post asked Maria Axfeldt, Hate Crime Coordinator at the Stockholm County Police, and Susanne Gosenius, Hate Crime Coordinator at the Skane (southern Sweden) County Police, about any surge in anti-Semitic activity related to the May 31 Gaza incident. Axfeldt said the police had not received reports of anti-Semitic hate crimes related to the incident, but the Jewish community in Stockholm notified the police that it received a small surge of calls and e-mails--primarily comments that were critical of the Israeli government's handling of the Flotilla. Gosenius said the Jewish community in southern Sweden reported to the police that several of its members received threats via e-mail, text messages, and phone calls, but there were no reports directly to the police of related hate crimes. (Note: Jewish communities in Sweden have their own security officials who monitor anti-Semitic threats to the community and liaise with the police. End Note.) According to some local media reports, anti-Semitic statements increased slightly on Swedish blogs and internet forums.
- 3. (SBU) Comment: In the past, Swedish authorities were slow to react to protect citizens when a controversial incident occurred in Israel, the West Bank or Gaza. This time, the authorities were better prepared to react quickly to protect the Jewish community. On May 31, the police in Sweden's three largest cities—Stockholm, Gothenburg and Malmo—immediately mobilized to protect Jewish community facilities and synagogues and there were no known reports of damaged property. This contrasts with early 2009, when the Gaza conflict resulted in property damage to Jewish community property. In Malmo, the "Dialogue Forum" (established in January 20010) was convened on May 31 for representatives from the Jewish and Muslim communities. The
