1. (SBU) Summary: Post has not witnessed a large number of anti-Semitic reactions to the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident, nor a significant increase in anti-Semitism overall since that incident. Egyptian press, editorialists, and political leaders continue to express harsh anti-Israel opinion. However, with the exception of a few political cartoons highlighted below, anti-Israel political expression has not crossed the line into anti-Semitism. End Summary

2. (SBU) Post has not found significant anti-Semitic material, as defined in Reftel A, in speeches and editorials by Egyptian political leaders regarding the Gaza flotilla incident. Some Egyptian editorialists continue to use language such as "Zionists" or "Jews." However, in the context of Egyptian political discourse, these terms are often used interchangeably with Israel or Israelis, without a secondary racial or religious connotation. For example, articles talked about "Zionist forces" assaulting the aid ships and the "Zionist occupation army" in Gaza, but these terms are used interchangeably with Israeli Defense Forces. This interchangeable use of terms has been the case both before and after the Gaza flotilla incident. A public affairs officer at the Israeli Embassy shared this same analysis on Egyptian political discourse, specifically that such language is not anti-Semitic without broader context.

3. (SBU) However, a number of political cartoons published after the flotilla incident, have had anti-Semitic elements. On June 2, Rose El-Yusuf, a pro-government paper, published a cartoon with the headline "The

Israeli Attack on the Freedom Flotilla." In an anti-Semitic caricature, the cartoon depicts an Israeli soldier as the devil, with a forked tail, jutting nose and chin, hands dripping blood, and a Star of David on his helmet. The soldier says, "I don't understand why the world is so shocked by me. I've been killing innocent people all my life and no one spoke to me (about it)..." A second cartoon, published on June 15 in Al Watani Al Youm, a progovernment newspaper, shows an aid ship being grabbed by an octopus carrying an Israeli flag with a Nazi swastika in place of the Star of David. The Israeli Embassy in Cairo sent a complaint to the newspaper. This is similar to a another cartoon published in Al-Youm As-Sabe, an independent online Egyptian news source, entitled "A Zio-American Arab Massacre." This cartoon reveals a sea monster with the Star of David destroying a ship.

1. (SBU) Summary: Embassy has not seen any reporting in the Libyan press on the Gaza flotilla incident that is expressly anti-Semitic. Libyan officials have repeatedly used anti-Israel language in reference to the incident, condemning the actions of the "Zionist entity, " (a term regularly used in the Libyan media) and Libyan media reports related to the Gaza flotilla episode have also been strongly critical of Israel and its policies. Post has not noted any public demonstrations or protests which have cross the line into anti-Semitism. End summary.

2. (SBU) Following the Gaza flotilla incident, there were numerous instances of anti-Israel language in Libyan press reports referencing the episode. Such statements were published

in several of Libya's state-owned publications. Al-Shams, a state-owned daily newspaper, referred to "the government of the so-called Israeli entity " in a July 19 article with the headline "Israeli Entity Creative in Humiliating Palestinians. " Libyan media outlets have also frequently used the word "Zionist" to derogatively refer to everything Israeli, including terming Israel the "Zionist Entity." In a July 18 article published by Azzahaf al-Akhdar, another state-owned daily newspaper, the author referred to Israeli Foreign Minister, Avigdor Lieberman, as a "Zionist terrorist...seeking to propose a plan to separate Israel and the Gaza Strip. " The article went on to reference Lieberman's so-called "Zionist " actions, referencing the state of Israel as "the enemy." Azzahaf al-Akhdar also published an article entitled, "Two-State Solution: Zionism, Zionists and Zionism Advocacy" on July 19 criticizing the West and the U.S. administration's treatment of the "Arab Zionist" conflict.

3. (U) In the wake of the Gaza flotilla incident, the Qadhafi International Charity and Development Foundation (QDF) run by Saif al-Islam al-Qadhafi, pro-reform son of Libyan leader Muammar al-Qadhafi, was strongly critical of Israeli military actions and government policies, but was careful not to use anti-Semitic language in its public statements. The QDF's official response to the Gaza flotilla incident criticized "the Israeli aggression as an expression of lack of respect for the international public opinion and values, and a crime by all standards at both the legal and moral levels committed in total disregard of international humanitarian law and the Geneva Conventions, and an assault on innocent citizens from around the world."

1. (SBU) SUMMARY: In response to ref A request, Post is not aware of any public statements by prominent leaders or in the media following the Gaza flotilla incident that would cross the line from being merely critical of Israel to anti-Semitic. Since our last reporting on Finnish reaction to the incident (ref B), there has been a pro-Israel demonstration (reportedly twice the size of the previously reported anti-Israel demonstration) and a visit by Israeli FM Lieberman. In a less positive vein, public broadcaster YLE decided to rebroadcast a radio program in which its commentator lamented that criticism of Israel is too often reflexively labeled anti-Semitic, a response which she alleged is inculcated into Israeli Jews from the time they are schoolchildren. The Israeli Embassy raised its concerns to YLE about their decision to rebroadcast the program shortly after the flotilla incident. END SUMMARY.

2. (U) Following and apparently in response to the June 1 demonstration against Israel's action against the Gaza flotilla, in which about 900 people participated (ref B), around 2000 people took part in a pro-Israel demonstration on June 10. According to media reports, most of the demonstrators were reportedly members of Christian groups or churches, though the event was reportedly coordinated with Finland's small Jewish community of some 1,500 residents.

LIEBERMAN VISIT POSITIVE, THOUGH MEDIA FOCUS ON CONTROVERSY

3. (SBU) Israeli Foreign Minister Avigdor Lieberman visited Helsinki on July 7 for meetings with President Halonen, FM Stubb, and Development and Trade Minister Väyrynen. The Israeli DCM provided a generally positive assessment to P-E Chief, noting that he was pleased that Lieberman was able to see the President (a meeting he described as "comfortable" in its atmosphere) as well as his GOF counterparts. While Israel and Finland didn't see eye to eye on all issues, both Stubb and Lieberman emphasized their strong bilateral relations in their meeting, which lasted twice as long as had been scheduled. The Foreign Ministers held a thirty-minute press conference following the meeting. The Israeli DCM lamented that the only portion of the press conference that aired on the Finnish news was a question from a documentary filmmaker about Israel's responsibility for the death of a Finnish UNIFIL peacekeeper in Lebanon in 2006. The question drew a vehement response from Lieberman, who accused the questioner of hypocrisy, and an attempted follow-up question was defily squelched by FM Stubb.

RADIO PROGRAM ALLEGES POLITICAL USE OF ANTI-SEMITISM

4. (SBU) Post's survey of Finnish media and public commentary since the Gaza flotilla incident revealed significant numbers of articles and statements both criticizing and supporting Israel, with others calling for a neutral assessment before any blame could be apportioned. None of the comments appeared to veer towards anti-Semitism.

5. (SBU) YLE, the national public broadcaster, did take the opportunity to rebroadcast a radio program by journalist Kirsi Virtanen in which she directly addressed the issue of anti-Semitism. In the broadcast Virtanen indicates that she does not see any anti-Semitism in Finland whatsoever but then goes on to question why those who criticize Israel are so often labeled as anti-Semitic. She offers her opinion that Israelis are brought up with a siege mentality in which they are taught that the outside world hates them and thus criticism from outside is automatically anti-Semitism. Many listeners posted comments on the program's webpage both supporting Virtanen's view ("at last someone is telling the truth," etc.) and attacking it for being ignorant of the situation Israel faces. The Israeli DCM related to P-E Chief that his embassy expressed their concerns to YLE after the original broadcast. When the embassy again raised the matter with YLE after the re-broadcast, it attributed the re-broadcast to a "technical error." 1. Per tasking in reftel, Embassy Banjul hereby submits the following report on reactions in The Gambia to the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident.

2. NO ANTISEMITIC STATEMENTS

Although The Gambia is predominantly a Muslim country, there have been no outward reactions to the May 31 attack by Israeli forces on a Palestinian flotilla in Gaza. In general, Gambians sympathize with the Palestinians, but there were no statements by political or religious leaders or demonstrations condemning the attack or remarks of an anti-Semitic nature. The media merely reported the incident without comment and in most cases carried syndicated reports from international news agencies and broadcast institutions such as CNN and the BBC.

3. Although most Gambian Muslims side with the Palestinians in their conflict with Israel, they also accept the teachings in the Koran that Christians and Jews are their cousins with whom they can inter-marry. They show no hatred for followers of the other two faiths.

1. (SBU) Post is not aware of any specific anti-Semitic reactions related to Gaza flotilla incident. There continues to be strong anti-Israel editorials and commentary both in the media and amongst the general public. The Government of Brunei (GoB) also condemned the Israeli government's actions. (NOTE: Brunei does not officially recognize the Government of Israel. End Note.) Media coverage of the incident was extensive in Brunei. A local paper, the Brunei Times, had two reporters who were part of the flotilla. Editorials throughout June strongly condemned the "Zionist" nation and its response to the flotilla as well as U.S. support for Israel. The Brunei Times extensive coverage may have played a role in triggering widely circulated text messages and emails to boycott any Israeli products. Local sermons in Brunei's mosques have not discussed or mentioned the Gaza flotilla incident.

(SBU) Per reftel, Poloff contacted the Israeli Community of Lisbon and reviewed news reports regarding anti-Semitism in the media or by the general public in Portugal related to the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident. There was a small demonstration in front of the Israeli Embassy in Lisbon shortly after the incident, and some negative public commentary in the press, but nothing that crossed the line from political expression to anti-Semitism. Anti-Semitic episodes are relatively rare in Portugal, which has a Jewish population of only about 1,000, according to the Israeli Community of Lisbon.

1. (U) Per Reftel, Post reviewed news media and statements by political leaders following the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident. Although the incident, which occurred close to Cyprus' territorial waters, received significant media coverage in both the Turkish Cypriot and Greek Cypriot communities, the coverage consisted mainly of political analyses and commentary and did not appear to "cross the line" into anti-Semitism.

2. (SBU) Post also contacted the leaders of the local Jewish community center in Larnaca, which reported no Gaza flotilla-related commentary or public statements that appeared to be anti-Semitic. The center did, however, report a slight increase after the Gaza flotilla incident in the number of verbal assaults and harassing phone calls, which they report receiving on a regular basis throughout the year. (Note: The Cyprus Jewish Community Center, led by members of the Chabad-Lubavitch Hasidic Orthodox faith, is located in Larnaca, an area with a significant number of Palestinian refugees. End note.) > Professional Associations Complex in Amman to protest the Israeli attack on activists onboard ships headed for Gaza. News sites said that demonstrators planned to convene at the Prime Ministry and the Israeli Embassy to demand the closure of the Israeli Embassy in Amman and the cancellation of the Wadi Araba peace agreement between Israeli and Jordan.

3. (SBU) "Jordanians Protest Israeli Aggression on Freedom Flotilla" (June 1) All dailies and many news sites (Ammonnews, Ammannet, Jordanzad, Ejjbed, Rumonline, Khaberni, Factjo, Allofjo, Assawsana) reported that hundreds of Jordanians demonstrated May 31 in protest of the Israeli forces' attack on the Freedom Flotilla convoy carrying humanitarian assistance to the people of the blockaded Gaza Strip. The Israeli attack left 19 activists dead and dozens injured. Demonstrators delivered a memorandum to Prime Minister Samir Rifai asking the government to inquire about the situation of Jordanians accompanying the vessels and ensure their safety. At least 23 Jordanians were onboard the Gaza flotilla, including prominent unionists and politicians. The Jordanian Medical and Bar Associations strongly condemned the Israeli attack in the open seas on the fleet carrying humanitarian aid. The Bar Association called for a withdrawal of the Arab peace initiative.

4. (SBU) Freedom Flotilla Coverage: (June 3) All papers continued to carry extensive coverage, focusing on the "heroes' welcome at the Professional Associations Complex for Jordanian activists. All papers also highlighted Foreign Minister Naser Judeh's strong remarks at the Arab Foreign Ministers meeting in Cairo, focusing on his statement that "the crime has exposed the Israeli government and revealed its evasion of peace." Papers continued to report on international reactions, especially Turkey's threat to reconsider its ties with Israel if Turkish activists were not released. Full inside pages continued to focus on reactions of condemnation and rejection of the Israeli "crime" by political parties, civil society organizations, and associations, as well as international reactions.

5. (SBU) Freedom Flotilia Coverage: (June 4-6) All papers continued to carry extensive follow-up coverage on developments related to the Freedom Flotilla issue. On June 6, headlines focused on Israel's "hijacking" of the Rachel Corey ship carrying assistance to Gaza. Reports also highlighted Turkey's decision to open a criminal investigation into the death of the Turkish activists on board the Freedom Flotilla, who were allegedly shot in the head at close range. Moreover, papers reported on the Turkish Prime Minister's reported consideration to visit Gaza, as well as continuing protests and demonstrations against Israel in various capitals around the world. News sites and dailies on the front of local sections highlighted official coverage of the thank you letter from Palestinian President Abbas to the King for Jordan's support to the Palestinian people. Reports also highlighted the departure of the Jordanian convoy carrying medical assistance to Gaza, and the medical treatment given to Freedom Flotilla activists at Al-Hussein Medical City.

6. (SBU) COMMENT: While much has been written and expressed about the Gaza flotilla incident in Jordan, especially in the local daily media and by political leaders, it is all apparently focused on anti-Israel political

(SBU) In response to the reftel action request, Post reports that the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident did not trigger anti-Semitic reactions by Cameroonian journalists, politicians, civil society organizations, or general public. Historically, Cameroon enjoys a reputation of religious tolerance and anti-Semitism has not been a problem in Cameroon. The Government of Cameroon maintains relatively good relations with the State of Israel and in the past has engaged in bilateral security cooperation. 1. (SBU) Summary. Leaders of Poland's Jewish community, as well as NGOs that monitor anti-Semitism, report no significant increase in anti-Semitism in Poland in the wake of the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident. Most NGOs note that anti-Semitic vandalism, including occasional desecration of Jewish cemeteries, is generally caused by hooligans whose views and behavior are the result of historical prejudices and stereotypes, unrelated to anti-Israeli sentiment. Polish government officials and Jewish community leaders continue to tell us that Poland and Israel enjoy close relations and that Poland is one of the strongest supporters of Israel in the EU. In the aftermath of the May 31 flotilia incident, there has been one (small) demonstration in front of the Israeli Embassy. With the exception of a dozen or so protesters, who stood apart from the rest of the group, none expressed anti-Semitic views. In addition, a few radical left-wing websites have used anti-Semitic rhetoric to condemn the flotilla incident, and some announcers on the Catholic ultraconservative Radio Maryja have reportedly used the flotilla incident to justify anti-Semitic comments. Ref B provides a general assessment of anti-Semitism in Poland. End Summary.

2. (SBU) Contacts at the Foundation for the Preservation of Jewish Heritage in Poland told us they have seen no evidence that the May 31 Gaza flotilla incident had caused an increase in anti-Semitism in Poland. Although there was an increase in June in acts of anti-Semitic vandalism over previous months and in comparison with June 2009, the Foundation's analysis concluded the perpetrators were not motivated by political events in the Middle East. Instead, they said the warmer-than-usual weather at night had encouraged potential vandals.

3. (SBU) According to contacts at the Open Republic Association, Polish anti-Semitism is generally not caused by anti-Israel sentiment, but derives from historical prejudices and stereotypes. Anti-Semitic vandalism and even violence are generally caused by hooligans, most of whom are neither politically aware nor motivated by ideology. Anti-Semitic rhetoric is mostly used in relation with internal affairs, and is employed by radical fringe political factions (especially those associated with the Catholic ultraconservative Radio Maryja) to condemn liberals or leftists.

4. (SBU) Open Republic recorded one minor demonstration, in front of the Israeli Embassy in Warsaw, to protest the Gaza

flotilla incident. According to Open Republic, demonstrators focused on human rights issues and did not employ anti-Semitic rhetoric. Moreover, demonstrators protested the actions of the Israeli government, but did not challenge the State of Israel's right to exist.

5. (SBU) According to contacts at the Forum for Dialogue Among Nations, the flotilla incident did not prompt an increase in anti-Semitic acts or rhetoric. Like other NGOs, Forum for Dialogue contacts told us Polish anti-Semitism stems mainly from local nationalist sentiment, rather than anti-Israeli, or even pro-Palestinian, views. They did note that a small number of radical left-wing Polish websites had responded to the Gaza flotilla incident with anti-Semitic rhetoric.

6. (SBU) Contacts at the Never Again Association took a slightly different view, arguing that although the flotilla incident had not specifically encouraged new expressions of anti-Semitism in Poland, it had in a few cases been used to justify and encourage existing anti-Semitic rhetoric. Although the demonstration at the Israeli Embassy had been a peaceful, left-wing protest focused on human rights, a small number of demonstrators, standing apart from the larger group, had used anti-Semitic rhetoric. Contacts at Never Again also noted that Radio Maryja announcers had used the flotilla incident to justify anti-Semitic comments.

journalists questioning the proportionality of the force was used by Israeli security forces. However, there was no media linkage of these events with the Jewish community per se. Following the incident, Switzerland's Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) called for "an international inquiry into the circumstances of this tragic event." It further stated that "the FDFA deplores the deaths of several civilians and the injuries caused including to members of the Israeli forces. It expresses its condolences to the families and friends of the victims. ... The FDFA invited the Israeli ambassador to provide further information about the event and to express its great concern."

2. (C) In response to our inquiry, the Swiss Federation of Jewish Communities indicates that it has received no reports of anti-Semitic violence following the incident. However, it notes that its members did report around a dozen anti-Semitic e-mails or telephone calls in the two months following the Gaza events, which the Federation thinks is somewhat above average. The Jewish Center Against Defamation (CICAD), which monitors anti-Semitic behavior in Switzerland, also informed us that it has received no reports of violence or vandalism directed against Jewish individuals or Jewish community property in Switzerland in the two months since the incident.

The Israeli DCM told us that his Ambassador, Benny Omer, had held a press conference on the issue on June 4, which was well received and useful in counteracting what he perceived to be the biased reporting of Agence France Press.

(C) During a speech in Turkey in June during the Conference on International and Confidence -Building Measures in Asia, the President of Azerbaijan, Ilham Aliyev, condemned the May 31 attack on the ship and expressed "our solidarity with Turkey, the Turkish people, [and] offer our condolences to the families of the martyrs."

A Parliamentary session on June 8 featured speeches by two members of Parliament that expressed similar views. However, Post has seen no connection between the GOAJ comments and a manifestation of anti-Semitism in Azerbaijan.

Media Reaction

4. (U) Media outlets largely provided news segments generated from Turkish media coverage of the events. Largely, these pieces decried Israeli actions and were anti-Israeli in nature. Again, Post has not observed a slip into anti-Semitism.

Civil society

5. (S/NF) Post noted that much of Azerbaijan civil society ignored the incident, with the exception of The Center for Protection of Conscience and Religious Freedom (or, the acronym for the Azerbaijani translation, DEVAMM), headed by Haji Ilgar Ibrahimoglu, which is engaged in the protection of rights of religious people in Azerbaijan. The organization published a statement accusing Israel of shedding the blood of peace activists and continuing the occupation of Palestine. On May 31, five DEVAMM activists conducted a protest in front of the Israeli Embassy in Baku; the protest was short-lived, as law enforcement quickly dispersed demonstrators. (NOTE:
