

Belgian Women File Lawsuit Against Israeli Military Officers Over Gaza Flotilla Treatment

- 1. (SBU) Four Belgian women have filed a lawsuit in Belgium against several senior Israeli military officers for alleged "degrading treatment and illegal detention" following their participation in the "Free Gaza Flotilla" in May.
- 2. (SBU) The lawsuit is based on Belgian legislation covering war crimes, crimes against humanity, and genocide, which adheres to the principle of "universal jurisdiction." The legislation dates from 1993 and was expanded in 1994, following the murder of 10 Belgian soldiers in Rwanda. In its original incarnation, the legislation was the basis for lawsuits filed in Belgian courts by non-Belgians against a number of foreign officials, including former President George W. Bush and former Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon. However, in 2003, the Belgian parliament revised the law to restrict the applicability of "universal jurisdiction," as of result of which cases can now only be filed when either the plaintiff or the defendant has a direct physical tie to Belgium (generally, when at least one of the parties resides in or is a citizen of Belgium.)
- 3. (SBU) The four Belgians -- Griet Deknopper, Inge Neefs, Fatima el-Mourabiti and Kenza Isnasni -- were in the flotilla, but not on the ship where nine Turkish activists lost their lives. They are bringing the charges against the Israeli armed forces, the Israeli Chief of Defense, and the commander of the raid on the Free Gaza flotilla. They also wanted the Israeli Prime Minister and Foreign Minister prosecuted, but because those officials enjoy immunity, they did not file suit against them.
- 4. (SBU) In addition to their allegations of degrading treatment and illegal detention, the women also accuse the Israelis of confiscating their equipment, including laptops and cameras. Their grievances were submitted in a 60-page dossier to the Belgian federal prosecutor on November 18.
- 5. (SBU) The Belgian Federal prosecutor now has one month to decide whether their complaints are admissible,

1. (U) This is an action request; please see paragraphs 3, 6 and

- 2. (U) The informal consultations on the 2010 UNGA Oceans resolution ended on Friday, November 12, 2010. The draft resolution that resulted from the consultations, reflected in the referenced email, is a satisfactory outcome
- 3. (U) USUN is requested to formalize U.S. co-sponsorship of this resolution.
- 4. (U) During informal consultations on this resolution, the Turkish delegation proposed the following paragraph based on text in the first paragraph of Security Council Presidential Statement

S/PRST/2010/9:

Expresses its deep regrets for the loss of life and injuries resulting from the use of force during the Israeli military operation in international waters against the convoy sailing to Gaza and, in this context, condemns those acts which resulted in the loss of nine civilians and many wounded as expressed by the Security Council Presidential Statement (S/PRST/2010/9) of 1 June

5. (U) The proposed text was not included in the draft resolution because it did not garner consensus. The United States objected to this proposal, because it was inappropriate for this type of resolution.

Israel, the European Union, Australia, New Zealand, Japan, Canada, and Fiji also objected. A number of delegations supported the proposal, including Argentina, Cuba, Malaysia, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Qatar, Venezuela, and Yemen.

6. (SBU) We understand that Turkey does not currently plan to propose to amend the oceans resolution by adding this paragraph to it, but should Turkey reintroduce this paragraph, USUN is requested to vote against the proposed paragraph and if necessary to call for a vote on this paragraph if no other delegation does so. USUN is requested to make an explanation of position/vote along the following lines: As expressed in our earlier statement, the United States believes that this year?s resolution on oceans and the law of the sea provides a constructive framework for progress in the coming years on a wide spectrum of marine -related issues, and we appreciate the spirit of cooperation exhibited by delegations involved in crafting the resolution. The United States does not support inclusion of the proposal to amend the resolution by adding the paragraph proposed by the delegation of Turkey. This paragraph would inappropriately politicize this oceans resolution. The oceans resolution is not the appropriate forum to address this matter.

1. (C) Political Officer delivered the concerns in reftel to Pakistan Ministry of	
Foreign Affairs on November 23.

2. (SBU) asserted that any such caravan of individuals and goods passing through Pakistan would require authorization from his office for visas. He suggested the visa process for such a caravan would be complicated and customs procedures even more so if they sought to move provisions and he doubted that the December 2 notional start date had any validity. was noncommittal on the central U.S. concern that aid flotillas seeking to deliver assistance to Gaza directly by sea should be discouraged. 3. (SBU) Embassy notes one web-based reference to a meeting in support of the caravan held in Lahore on November 9, centered on the Labour Education Foundation, at paksforpal.wordpress.com.
