

Regional stability is essential, he said, but peace and stability cannot be achieved while there is occupation. CDA stressed the U.S. government's concern with humanitarian issues in Gaza, noting that there are internationally-agreed land routes for transportation of humanitarian assistance. The Peace Process is deeply engaged in issues such as land, movement, and access, he said, and the focus of U.S. government concern about the flotilla is its use of approved ports of entry for humanitarian assistance.






