



It costs approximately

**\$445 million\***

**\$445 million**

could educate 37,753 students for a year, based on the 2015-16 U.S. per pupil spending average of \$11,787.



**\$445 million**

would cover \$20 copays for 2.5 doctor visits for each of the 8.9 million children enrolled in the Children's Health Insurance Program, which Congress is guaranteeing funding only through Jan. 19, 2018.



**\$445 million**

could feed nearly 40,000 families of four for one year based on the average of \$217 a week.



**\$445 million**

would almost cover the \$460 million needed to keep alive the Choice program, which enables veterans to get health care outside the Veterans Affairs system. Veterans Affairs Secretary David Shulkin announced in December 2017 that he was eliminating the program.
