Hello Gregg and Keesha,

As you both have probably seen we've filed emergency motions last night and today in [REDACTED]. We are unsure where Mr. [REDACTED] is and have reason to believe he is being scheduled for removal sometime today. This all occurred without notice and we would like you to ask your client about Mr. [REDACTED]'s whereabouts and what his status is.

We know that the ICE detainee locator still says he is at Adams but ICE's detainee locator system is notoriously unreliable and slow to update. We have personal experiences with clients who have been transferred and their location was not updated for 24 hours or multiple days, especially when the move is in connection with one of these shadowy third-country deportation attempts. In this case, although we have been unable to make contact with our client, he was able to contact his wife last night to tell her he was being moved, and we have received information from multiple credible sources that individuals who are being staged for deportation to CAR were transferred to Alexandria, LA.

The GTL messaging system for detainees at Adams also indicates that he is no longer at the facility.

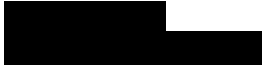
